The lockers on the third floor are very narrow. Really big backpacks like the ones with wheels don't fit. The students don't have huge textbooks, so a smaller backpack will work well. There may be sales going on, so even if you don't use a back back extensively this year, it may be worth getting one for next year.

Each locker will have a lock for which students are responsible. Students are required to use their assigned locks all year. Lockers are not to be left unlocked. If the lock is lost, it must be replaced at the student's expense.

There will not be any decorations on the outside of the lockers. Students will be allowed to celebrate birthdays in other ways, but the outside of all the lockers must be clear. They can decorate the inside of their own locker, but they are only allowed to use magnets or blue painters tape.
