First peer observation cycle is complete- foster collaboration and feedback; NWEA testing was completed on 10/6/2017 by K-8; professional development has begun; master schedule allows all grade level teachers to have shared morning meeting/advisory periods; bus drill completed; CPS approved capital improvements for the north and west lots; student council reps presented and signed new social contract; student council officer elections were held last week.
 - b. REACH observations began on 10/2; 1 on 1 meetings with teachers are complete; MTSS team is finalizing roster of students who need extra support and will soon schedule time to provide support; searching for teacher assistant to offer support to classroom teachers; each ILT member will lead one Professional Learning Communities; grade level meetings held; ThickCerca has been implemented by upper grade literacy teachers.

Staff participating in advisory cohort planning workshops and professional development; teachers have met with Ms. Spicer to set professional goals for school year; Ms. Jacobson has begun to meet with 8th grade class re. HS and has begun teaching social emotional lessons in K-3 classrooms, and teaching 6-th-

8th graders about Naviance; SNUG is up and running the superstore and selling coffees; 7th grade schedule is flexible to allow students to have classes with different groups of students in morning and afternoon; Student Council is in place.

Newsletter has been sent out more frequently during Dr. Magnuson's leave, upon her return, revert to monthly cycle; Back to School Parent Coffee on 1st day of school- FOSN and Admin; FOSS kits to another CPS school in need- FOSN and ADMIN; Stanton Park Playground is estimated to be completed on 10/30; working with CPD on car break in issue; repair/replacing 2 existing cameras; Anti-bullying them for Oct-Diversity Comm and Admin; 1st upper grade social at King Bowl (6th-8th grade)- SNUG and Admin; Internet Safety Presentation- Wellness Comm and Admin; Walk a Thon- Wellness Comm and Admin.
